Please make an appointment to visit a Waterbury Housing Hub, one of our local drop-in centers. You do not need an appointment if you visit during walk-in hours. Any language can be accommodated.

If you can't reach us or need help scheduling, call 2-1-1 (press 3, then 1) for assistance from 8am-4pm Monday-Friday, including holidays.

WHO WE HELP

You can come to a Waterbury Housing Hub if you are:

- Homeless right now, or
- Will be homeless within the next 14 days

If you do not meet these criteria but still need help, please contact the organizations listed at the bottom of this flyer.

WHAT WE DO

Trained professionals at the Waterbury Housing Hub can help you:

- Explore potential housing and emergency shelter options. PLEASE NOTE: Shelter might not be immediately available.
- Connect you with local food pantries and soup kitchens
- Connect you with other local support services and agencies
